

Asthma Management and Monitoring



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Asthma is a chronic inflammatory disorder of the airways that affects more than 2 million Australians, including approximately 16% of children. If uncontrolled, asthma can severely impact your quality of life.

What to expect at your visit

1. Sign in at the electronic kiosk to see a nurse practitioner. No appointment necessary.
2. Your nurse practitioner will review your medical history, discuss your symptoms, perform an examination and may run tests such as spirometry and pulse oximetry.
3. We'll review and explain your results and discuss your action plan.
4. We can show you how to correctly perform peak flow measurements, use your inhaler or spacer correctly and track your progress. And we will write prescriptions when medically appropriate.
5. A visit summary will be sent to your primary care provider with your consent.

How much does the program cost and can I get a rebate?

- Standard consult fee applies.
- Medicare and health insurance rebates apply.

What to know before your visit

- Patients who are younger than 7 years of age or older than 65 will be referred to another care setting.
- Patients who are pregnant will be referred to another care setting.
- Patients with moderate to severe asthma symptoms such as wheezing or shortness of breath will be referred to another care setting.

What's a Nurse Practitioner?

Nurse Practitioners are highly experienced registered nurses with advanced education and training in the diagnosis, management and prevention of common health conditions. They have the authority to prescribe medication, refer to specialists and order diagnostic tests.
